Re: All-Star Team Commitment

Dear Managers, Coaches, Parents, and Players:

Each year, the Norco Girls Softball (NGS) Board reviews the highlights of the prior year's All-Star Program to make improvements. Our goal is to ensure that All-Star players make the team based upon their playing ability and that the selected qualified managers are highly committed to motivate players at this advanced level of play. The intent of this letter is informational, so that you know the program and participant expectations.

Interested All-Star participants need to answer these tough questions honestly before making the All-Star commitment:

- ✓ Are you ready for the commitment?
- ✓ Are you ready to give up summer vacations?
- ✓ Are you ready for the financial commitment?
- ✓ Are you ready for extra practices?
- ✓ Can you objectively support your manager without questioning their decisions related to how often or what position(s) your daughter plays?
- ✓ Are you ready to be part of something that is an honor and privilege?
- ✓ Are you ready to represent your City and NGS?

If you have any reservations, then an All-Star Team commitment is not currently right for you. If you can honestly answer yes to these questions, without hesitation, then you are ready to consider an All-Star Team commitment.

Here are some All-Star Team facts of interest:

All-Star Team Selection

NGS will have at least one team representing each division in the 6U, 8U, 10U, 12U, 14U and 16/HS divisions. (Only if enough players come forth to build a team).

The Approved Manager of each team will then immediately contact each approved player to inform them of their selection and confirm each player's uniform jersey sizes and preferred jersey number in order to advise the Board at once.

All non-selected players will be contacted by their division's Player Agent to thank them for their participation.

manager be a manager or coach/assistant coach in the age division in which they manage, however, managers or coaches/assistant coaches from other age divisions may request to be considered for different age divisions. Managers must be in good standing with NGS and support the ideals of the league. If there are no qualified managers or coaches/assistant coaches who are willing to manage an All-Star Team, the board may recruit from all qualified Player Agents and/or Board Members. All-Star Team managers must be approved by the Board.

Each All-Star team will consist of up to 12 players and it is at the sole discretion of the All-Star Team manager to determine who gets playing time. The essential rules from the regular playing season such as equal playing time and infield rotation do not apply during the All-Star season. The managers/coaches will play the All-Star Team players where they feel is best for the team and the players will most likely play a specific position on the field. In some cases, the manager may only choose to bat nine (9) players, use the DP/Flex/EH system, or bat the whole team. It is up to the All-Star Team managers/coaches as to how to manage the team.

There is the possibility that your daughter will not play but an inning or two throughout the entire All-Star season. While we, as a Board, hope this does not happen, please note that the Board does not control this matter, as it is at the sole discretion of the All-Star Team managers to make all necessary playing decisions.

If a manager, coach, or player did not fulfill their commitment in the previous All-Star or Select season (i.e. quit the team, was removed from the team, had conduct detrimental to the team by player, parent, or supporter of player, or in any way the Board deemed a violation of contract), they are not eligible for All-Star or Select Team consideration for the current or following season.

## **ALL-STAR COSTS**

- NGS covers the following tournaments for 8U, 10U, 12U, and 14U divisions (6U & 16/HS tournaments to be chosen by The Board and Manager if there is a team formed).
- Parents will be financially responsible for any extra tournaments including Districts, States, and Nationals.
- Parents are responsible for all hotel and travel costs.
- Parents are financially responsible for all gear decided upon by the Managers (all information will be provided at the first team meeting).
- A deposit of \$500 will be due at the first team meeting.
- A deposit of \$100 per player will be due for the snack bar. If you work your shift during our Stampede Tournament, your check will be returned to you after your shift.
- 6U & 16/HS division will not need to make a \$100 deposit for the snack bar due to no 6U & 16/HS teams in the Norco Stampede Tournament. If these two divisions are added to the Stampede tournament, the \$100 per player deposit for the snack bar will be required immediately.
